July 31, 2008 is set for an all day trial.

This day shall be used as a further trial setting conference and to determine if the temporary letters will be extended or to set a hearing/trial on the permanent conservatorship. Mr. Ingham shall advise the Court of his client's position regarding a jury trial.

The morning session will address the financial issues.

The afternoon session will address the temporary conservatorship.

Financial information shall be provided to the Court by July 11, 2008. If any experts will be called, counsel shall file and serve their designation by July 11, 2008.

Counsel shall meet and confer by July 18, 2008 to discuss if they will be calling experts as to the conservatorship of the person. If any experts will be called, counsel shall file and serve their designation by July 18, 2008.

If there will be a report pursuant to Evidence Code 730, the report shall be filed and served under seal by July 11, 2008.

A joint trial statement is ordered, with portion under seal as necessary, and shall be filed not later than noon July 25, 2008.

The ex parte was discussed in chambers, and counsel shall redraft the order per this discussion.
